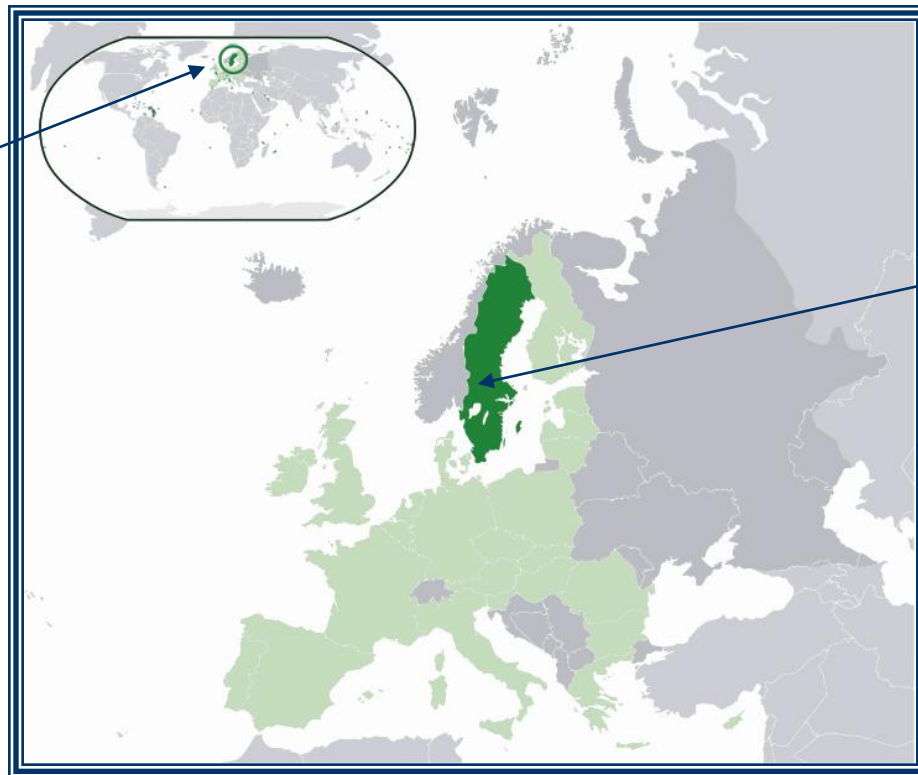

- Capital: Stockholm (847 073 inhabitants)
- Inhabitants: 9, 5 million people
- Size: 449 964 km<sup>2</sup> (number 5 in Europe after Russia, Ukraine, France and Spain)
- Constitution: Monarchy
- Language: Swedish
- Currency: Swedish kronas (1€  $\approx$  10 kronas)

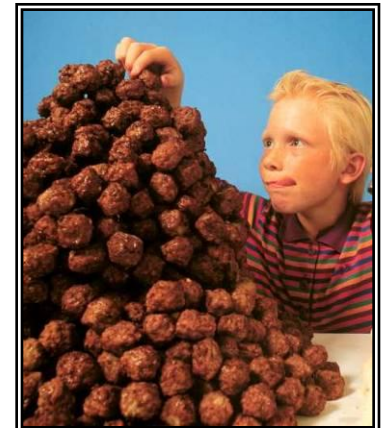


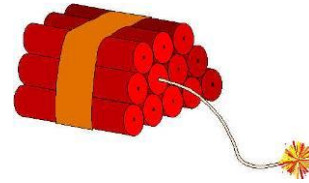

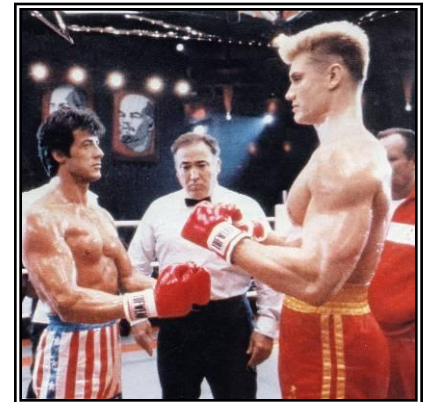


## Other famous Swedes

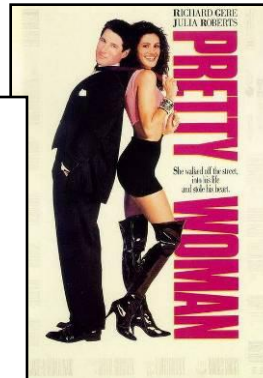
